Pool Guest Policy

• To bring a guest to the pool, present your pool pass and the guest(s) will be deducted from your account. Residents must accompany their guests at all times. Each property is given 12 guest visits per year. However, you may only bring in four (4) guests at a time.

You can no longer purchase additional guest passes at the pool, however you can purchase them:

- Online Go to "Amenities" and "SR Swimming Pools". Click on the link to purchase. Residents must be in good standing to purchase. Visa or MasterCard will be accepted online with a 50 cent service fee. Passes can be purchased at any time and will be applied to your account.

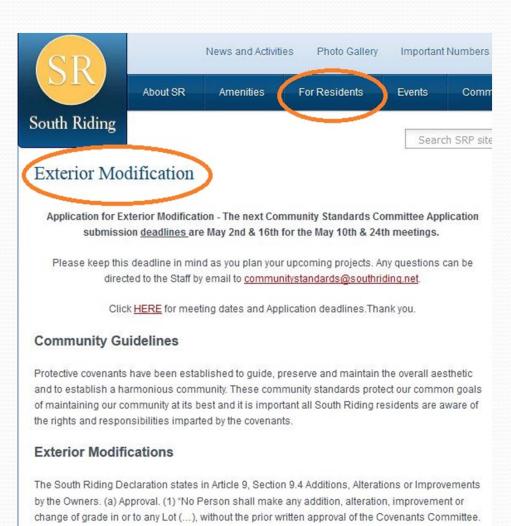
