

Open Space Notes

October 8, 2019

1. Bike Track

- County completed the wetland study and surveyed the potential site. There is possibility that a “use” exception may be needed. There will be Cost increase if a pedestrian bridge is needed. Possible we could have the project approved for installation in 6 months.

2. Front Entrance Design

- VDOT is requiring Toll to lower the “mound” that would require removal of the cherry trees at the front entrance on SR BLVD. This has accelerated the project.
- Plans were reviewed, with a discussion of parking option. The consensus was that we should install a sidewalk to allow pedestrians access.
- Other goals are to incorporate a historical monument.
- To allow for more open space we will move the flags closer to Rt 50.

3. Replacing Signs

- Samples for the entrance sign at Lands’ End shown to group. Raised letters or engraved letters
- Mr. Salmon moved and Mr. Corej 2nd the motion to use the **raised letter** sign

4. Parks Updates

- Survey needed for West Riding open space. Possible teen/passive park for West Riding. Staff will get more information and plans
- Property on Braddock update they are requesting annexation into SRP.
- Elk Lick Park discussion regarding removing the volleyball court and add a pickle ball court next to the basketball court – staff will get more information and plans
- We are moving forward with Bryson and Burkedale parks replacement projects
