DISPOSING OF LARGE HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Large household items are any items weighing more than 50 pounds or longer than 4 feet in length, and are listed below under ALLOWED. Please call or email *Republic Services* to preschedule a pickup for large items, please note there is a fee for this service. Please provide your telephone number when scheduling a pickup and do not place your large items out for pickup until you receive confirmation of your pickup date from *Republic Services*.

ALLOWED

Please call Republic Services to schedule a pickup, if you would like to dispose of any of the following large items. Wait for your pickup date to be confirmed before placing items out at the curb.

Furniture

(Includes mattresses, sofas, chairs, tables)

Lawn furniture

(oil and gas must be drained)

Basketball goals

(pole must be broken down to 4-5' to fit in collection vehicle)

Microwave ovens

Area rugs

(sizes up to 8x10)

Toys

Books, clothing, knick-knacks

Dishes, pots and pans

NOT ALLOWED

Items which are too large or heavy to be lifted safely by a two-person crew or too large to fit into the collection vehicle will NOT be picked up by Republic Services and must be disposed of by the Resident or Homeowner according to Loudoun County guidelines.

Please check the Loudoun County Waste Management page on the Loudoun County website for more information. Alternately, you may contact a junk hauling company for disposal options. The following items will NOT be picked up by Republic Services.

Construction Debris

Construction debris, including drywall, cement board, shingles and insulation

Lumber/Wood/Pallets

Bricks, tiles, concrete products, rocks or stones

Kitchen cabinets, counter tops, vanity, sink, toilet

Carpeting and padding

Large Furniture

Pianos

Pool tables

Large Appliances

Washer/Dryer

Barbecue grills

Dishwashers

Refrigerator, freezer, A/C unit and other refrigeration equipment that has not had the chemical refrigerant removed by a licensed technician

Automotive

Tires (on or off rim)

Riding mowers

Automotive parts

E-Waste

Computers, monitors, TVs, other electronics

Floor model copiers and printers

Hazardous Waste

Hazardous household waste (paints, stains, pesticides, etc.)

Yard Waste

Tree limbs, tree stumps, logs, firewood or yard waste (see Yard Waste)

Lawnmowers and other power equipment
