

2024 BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION Candidate Information and Guidelines

The following is available to all candidates for the South Riding Proprietary 2024 Board of Directors Election. These guidelines are provided to promote a fair and positive election and to ensure a balanced and consistent distribution of candidate materials during the campaign period.

Potential candidates are encouraged to schedule an orientation with the General Manager to learn about the responsibilities, duties and opportunities related to Board membership. It is the candidate's responsibility to schedule the orientation, either virtually or in person.

As a prospective leader of the South Riding Proprietary, candidates are expected to ensure that any campaign materials reflect the positive nature of their campaign. There will be no campaigning using Proprietary maintained email distribution lists. Candidates will adhere to the South Riding Design & Maintenance Standards as related to posting or distributing of campaign materials. All campaign materials are to be properly disposed of after the completion of the election.

Candidates must adhere to all community guidelines as outlined in the South Riding Proprietary documents, including but not limited to, the Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws, Design & Maintenance Standards and the Elections Rules & Guidelines.

Candidates are encouraged to attend the May 2^{nd} Board of Directors meeting, at 7pm. This is an excellent opportunity for the candidates to speak to the current Board members and residents in attendance.

Candidate nominations are due to Town Hall by 5pm on Thursday March 21st. Election results will be announced during the Annual Meeting on Tuesday, May 21st.
