

## Street Tree Canopy Maintenance

Historically South Riding mulches street\* trees and elevates the canopy up to 12'-15' feet. In 2023, in the four oldest sections of the community, we tested an additional service, a complete canopy maintenance and pruning,

2024 – 2030 - Going forward we are budgeting for this service for all street trees for the entire community. It will be provided on a systematic schedule, continuing in order of age (oldest home sections to newest). In short, we hope to provide this service on a 5–7-year regular schedule.

In order to maintain and manage costs, deviation from the schedule or special requests will not be available. Should a homeowner wish, they are more than welcome to have a professional prune their tree at the homeowner's expense as has been our historic tradition.

Please note, we will not be pruning the canopies of the locust trees. They are nearing the end of their life cycles and are being monitored for removal. We anticipate that in the next 2-3 years the majority of the locust trees will have died.

The 2024 schedule of work (see below) has been contracted and the work is underway.

The work will be completed by a team of professionals with an arborist overseeing the work. This maintenance and pruning will be completed on the entire tree with the goal of improving the health and storm resistance of the trees as well as trimming them away from nearby light poles and homes.

*\*Street trees are those trees located in the right of way easement between the sidewalk and the street.*

***Remove branches shown with dotted lines:***

**Remove limbs that extend beyond the natural crown of the tree.**

**Remove dead, broken or crossing limbs**

**Remove limbs that turn inward towards the trunk.**

**Do not leave branch stubs.**

**Remove root suckers and sprouts.**

**Remove competing stems to develop a single trunk.**

**Shorten low branches to develop trunk thickness**
