

## Nations Street and Tall Cedars Parkway Intersection – Timeline and Summary

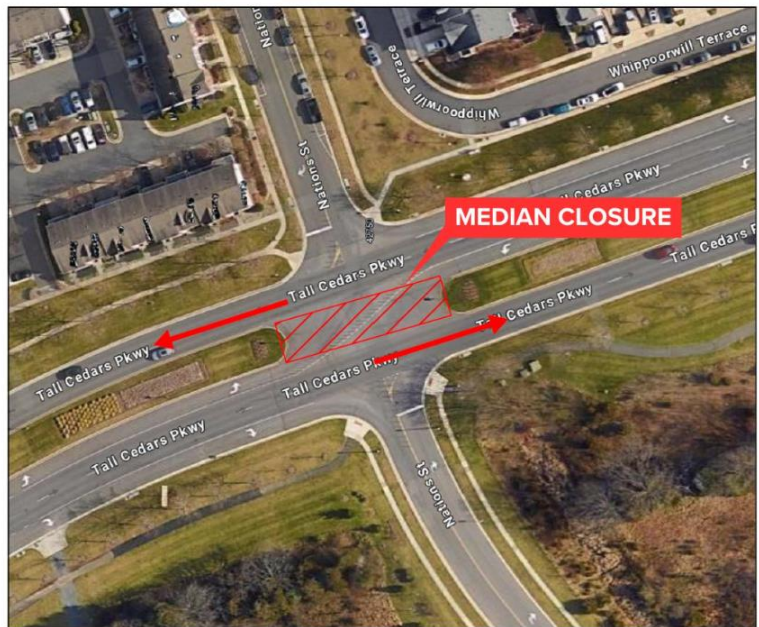
Loudoun County and VDOT have secured funding to finalize this intersection permanently restricting Nations Street traffic from crossing or turning left onto Tall Cedars Parkway. The intersection design will be very similar to what was completed at the Loudoun County Parkway and Center Street.

The hope is the project will be completed fall 2024. Application materials submitted to the County can be viewed online at <https://loudouncountyvvaeg.tylerhost.net/prod/selfservice#/home> then select 'search public records', type the application number in the search box. Application number is: CRCP-2022-0004.

**October 8, 2024** - Beginning October 9, the median at Tall Cedars Parkway and Nations Street will be temporarily closed for construction for approximately two weeks. Vehicles will need to use an alternate route to access Nations Street. Drivers should use caution when driving in this area and follow posted signs.

## Temporary Median Closure

Beginning October 9, 2024, there will be a temporary median closure at Tall Cedars Parkway and Nations Street for approximately two weeks.

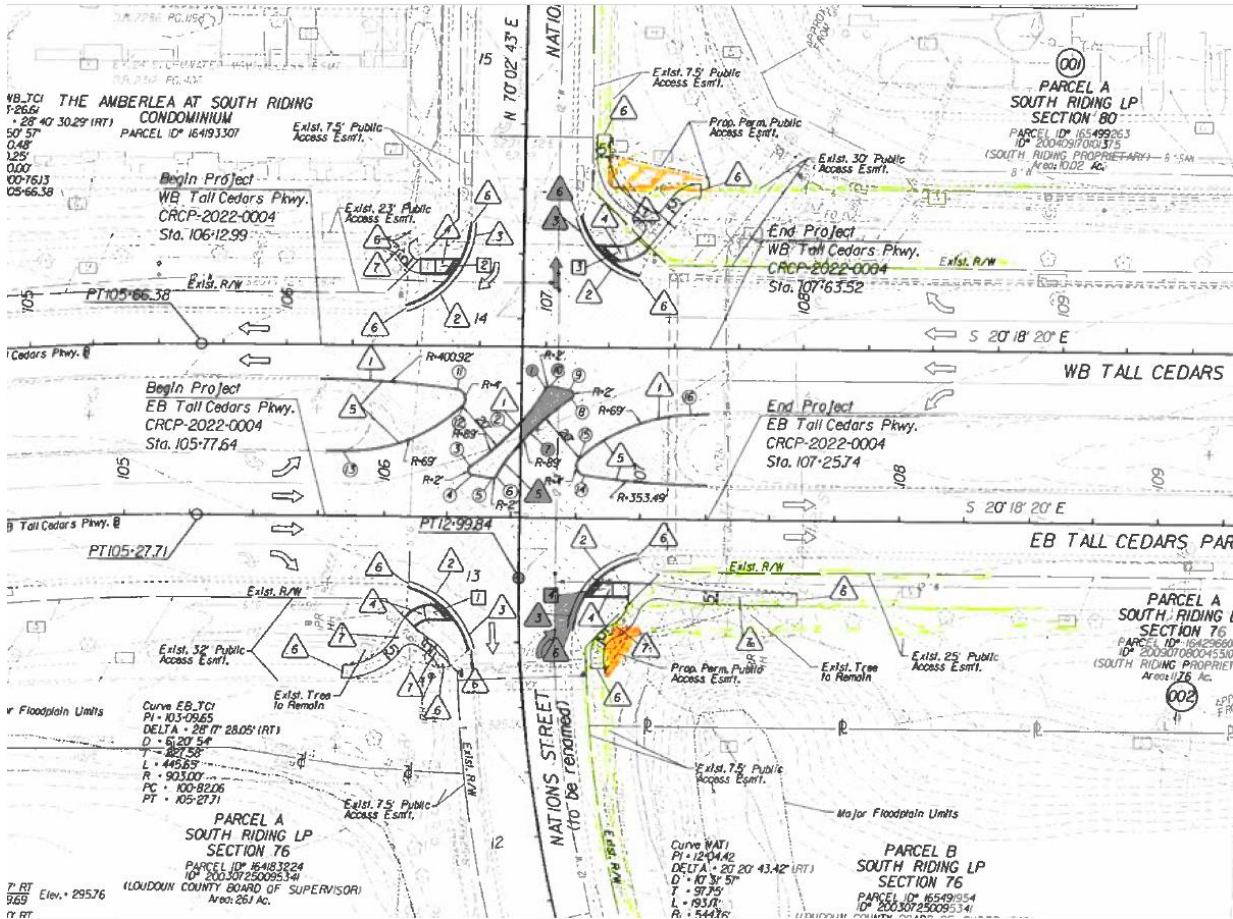
**September 10, 2024** - Below is an excerpt from Dulles South County Supervisor Matt Letourneau's August 29<sup>th</sup> newsletter.

*The project to convert the temporary flex posts at the intersection of Tall Cedars Parkway and Nations Street in South Riding to a permanently constructed configuration will be starting soon. A contractor is on board to complete the work and is currently working through the bond process. They are submitting permit applications to VDOT and once those have been issued, work will begin. We expect that to happen this fall, and the construction timeline should be relatively short. I will provide more information once a start date has been set.*

**May 23, 2024** – VDOT completed their scheduled paving work and re-established the temporary components of this intersection. Loudoun County plans to complete the finalization of the intersection later this summer or fall.

**April 9, 2024** – The South Riding Board of Directors approved the easement request at their April 4<sup>th</sup> meeting and the signed and notarized documents were collected by County Staff today.

**March 21, 2024** – Offer from Loudoun County for 368 square feet of land they need to acquire from the community was received and forwarded to SR's legal counsel and Board of Directors for review.



**August 28, 2023** – Update from Supervisor Letourneau’s office “The construction plans are approved, and they are working through getting easement plats finalized to secure Public Access Easements from SRP. Based on the plan, they have to make some changes to the sidewalk/trail at the corners and some of those changes are outside of existing ROW and Public Access Easements...”
