**Operations Department:** Operations Board report provided to P&R Committee for review.

The annual South Riding Dog Swim was held on September 6th, with a total of 67 dog participants and their humans attending.

Courts: The pickleball court rules sign has been installed. The basketball court rules sign is scheduled for installation. The remote for the Elk Lick Park court lights is scheduled to be installed in September. The basketball court repairs have been completed, and the court is now open. Both the Murrey tennis court and the Town Hall tennis court have new message boards installed.
