

LARGE & BULK TRASH PICKUP TIPS



Proper disposal of large household items helps keep our community clean, safe, and attractive for everyone. Before placing any bulk items at the curb, please review the following tips.

ALLOWED = Must be small enough to fit in the collection vehicle AND not too heavy for a two-person crew to safely lift.

NOT ALLOWED = Hazardous, Big like a piano, Construction debris, Flammable

Large household items are defined as any items weighing more than 50 pounds or longer than 4 feet in length.

SCHEDULE A LARGE ITEM PICKUP WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES

Residents must call 703-818-8222 or email southriding@republicservices.com to schedule a pickup for large items. Please note that there is a fee for this service.

ALLOWED ITEMS

FURNITURE: Mattresses, Sofas, Chairs, Tables
BASKETBALL GOALS: Pole must be broken down to 4-5 foot sections to fit in the collection vehicle
HOUSEHOLD ITEMS: Microwave ovens, Toys, Books, Clothing, Dishes, Pots and pans
AREA RUGS: Sizes up to 8x10'

NOT ALLOWED

CONSTRUCTION & YARD DEBRIS: Drywall, Cement board, Shingles, Insulation, Lumber, Wood, Pallets, Bricks, Tiles, Concrete products, Rocks or stones, Tree limbs, Tree stumps, Logs, Firewood
REMODELING MATERIALS: Kitchen cabinets, Countertops, Vanities, Sinks, Toilets, Carpeting and padding
LARGE FURNITURE & APPLIANCES: Pianos, Pool tables, Washers and dryers, Barbecue grills, Dishwashers, Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioning units, and other refrigeration equipment that have NOT had the chemical refrigerant removed by a licensed technician.
AUTOMOTIVE ITEMS: Tires (on or off rim), Riding mowers, Automotive parts

E-WASTE: Computers, Monitors, TVs, Other electronics, Floor-model copiers and printers
HAZARDOUS WASTE: Paints, Stains, Pesticides, Other hazardous household waste

Alternative Disposal Options

Loudoun County Landfill & Recycling Options

Many construction materials, appliances, electronics, yard waste, and hazardous household materials may be disposed of through Loudoun County waste and recycling facilities. Residents are encouraged to review current guidelines, accepted materials, fees, and operating hours before transporting items.

Examples of items commonly handled through county facilities or specialty recycling programs include: Construction debris, Refrigerators and appliances, Electronics and TVs, Tires, Paints, stains, and pesticides, Automotive fluids and hazardous materials

Junk Hauling Services

Many companies offer curbside pickup, in-home removal, and same-day service for a fee.

Common providers in the area include: 1-800-GOT-JUNK, College Hunks Hauling Junk, Junk King, LoadUp or search for local independent hauling companies.

Retailer Take-Back Programs

Some retailers will haul away old appliances, mattresses, or electronics when delivering new items. Residents purchasing replacement appliances or furniture should consider paying for the convenient retailer haul-away or recycling services at the time of purchase.

Say NO to Dumping in Common Areas

Unfortunately, from time to time, bulk items such as furniture, mattresses, televisions, etc. are left in common areas instead of being

disposed of properly. They create an eyesore and result in removal costs that impact the entire community.

If you happen to see items being improperly discarded in a common area, we encourage residents to report it to Town Hall as soon as possible. Send photos, vehicle descriptions, or other helpful details to townhall@southriding.net to help us identify the responsible party.

The Proprietary will seek reimbursement from residents responsible for improper disposal whenever possible.

Planning ahead and using the proper disposal channels helps keep our community clean, safe, and attractive for everyone.
