COLLECTION TIPS

COLLECTION DAYS: Monday & Thursday (service runs until 6:30 p.m.)



- ◆ **BAG IT** – All household waste should be securely bagged. Loose or leaking trash creates messes and attracts pests.
- ◆ **USE A CONTAINER** – Place bagged trash inside your Republic Services container.
- ◆ **NEED A CONTAINER?** – Email southriding@republicservices.com with your name, HOA name, size container 64 or 96 gallon.
- ◆ **SUNRISE** – 6 a.m. - Place the container at the curb by 6 a.m. on collection day.
- ◆ **PLACEMENT** – Set containers as close to the street as possible. Do not block sidewalks.
- ◆ **CONTAINER DIRECTION** – Wheels toward the house. This helps prevent debris from catching on the lid and spilling into the street.
- ◆ **PROHIBITED ITEMS** – These items don't go in your trash container: Paint, chemicals, batteries, electronics, construction debris, battery-powered devices (like scooters), and similar items.
- ◆ **AGAIN, NO PAINT** – Contamination (especially paint) can take a truck out of service for cleaning, delaying the entire route.
- ◆ **TIMING VARIES** – Drivers may run routes in a different order due to staffing levels. Expect some variation—especially during prime vacation times during the summer and around holidays.
- ◆ **HOLIDAYS** – No collection on Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, or New Year's Day. Make-up days are posted at southriding.net (Home Page and Trash & Recycling page).

- ◆ **WEATHER** – Inclement weather can delay service. Make-up days are posted at southriding.net (Home Page and Trash & Recycling page).

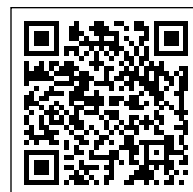
